



Vishnu Sahasranamam parayanam

The usual routine for the parayanam is:

- 7 PM - 7:30 PM - Vishnu Saharsanamam
- 7:30 - 7:35 PM - Lakshmi Ashtotharam
- 7:35 - 7:45 PM - Hanuman Chalisa
- 7:45 - 8:15/8:30 PM - Bhajans/Songs
- 8:15/8:30 PM - Arati and then prasadam in the Vedanta Hall.

We try and keep to the times and schedule, but depending upon the day and the number of people, there may be slight variations in individual times and an overall variation of about 10 minutes in the finish time.

The parayanam of Vishnu Sahasranamam and Lakshmi Ashtotharam is done the 'traditional' way and Hanuman Chalisa is usually sung the way MS Subbulakshmi has.
